## Introduction: Greater than





'Imagine you are a hungry brick-eating creature. You always eat the BIGGEST brick! Draw your mouth that will look like < or > so that the open part of your mouth is facing the biggest brick.







8 is greater than 1 or 8 > 1

For example: the brick above with 8 studs is bigger than the brick with 1 stud.

Question: If you were a hungry brick-eating creature and you wanted the biggest meal, which brick would you eat? Yes you would want to eat the big red brick with 8 studs on it.

This means that 8 is greater than 1.
