# What to do with the birthday month posters

- Print the resource, 1 month per page
- Laminate (this is optional)
- If you have laminated the page, use a whiteboard marker to write each student's name in a brick that corresponds with their birthday month (then at the end of the year, you can wipe off and start again)
- If you do not laminate the page, use any marker to write each student's name in a brick that corresponds with their birthday month.
- Add the date of the birthday (if you choose to), and use any format that aligns with how you will be teaching dates. (i.e. Monday 23, 2-2-2022, 8/7/2026)
- Put on your classroom wall for all to see.
- NOTE: If you have more than 8 students with a birthday in a certain month, print additional pages for that month.
